- Victim/Survivor of an intentional crime (brief list below) within the past three years or homicide of an immediate family member (no time limit)
 - Guns Shot
 - Stabbing
 - Physical Assault
 - Sexual Assault
 - Robbery/Burglary
 - Domestic Violence
 - · Hit and Run Accident
 - Elder Abuse
 - Hate Crime
 - · Stalking and Harassment
 - Human Trafficking
